## For fun and fine motor skills!

What is printmaking? In printmaking, ink or other materials are transferred from a “matrix” to a material like paper, fabric, wood, or stone. The matrix used for printmaking can be many things, such as a block of material such as wood, rubber, or metal.

This four session, hands-on workshop will provide kids with:
